6.2.4 The need for continuity in the waterproofing protection should also be considered when selecting a type of protection. In most circumstances, the protection should be continuous.

For product installation this drawing is to be read in conjunction with all relevant product data sheets.

Adprufe Design Criteria
Concrete structures must be designed in accordance with BS EN 1992-1-1, BS EN 1992-1-2, BS EN 1992-3 and BS 8102, or a comparable code.
Concrete containing Adprufe should be designed in accordance with the requirements of BS EN 1992-1-1 having a maximum crack width of 0.3mm; water retaining structures should be designed in accordance with BS EN 1992-3 having a maximum crack width of 0.2 mm, when the hydrostatic Pressure/wall thickness is ≤ 5 .
